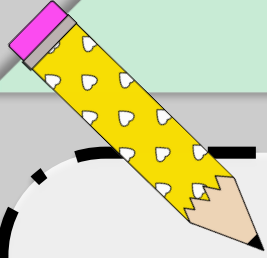


This week in: Mrs. Klaus' Class



We are learning:
